THE WINERY

Founded in the early 2000s by Josep Grau upon a base of Garnatxa and Samsó (Carignan) vines between 40 and 100 years of age in the traditional Priorat villages of Marçà, Capçanes and Falset. Llicorella, chalk and clay terroirs exist side by side, allowing for subtle interplay between boldness and minerality. Maximum attention is paid to minimization of oak influence.

THE WINE

80% Garnatxa and 20% Samsó. from old vines, aged 8 to 10 months in French oak cooperage of 225, 300 and 500 liters.

IN THE PRESS

Vespres 2008 "The 2008 Vespres is made up of 80% Garnacha and 20% Samsó aged in various sizes of French oak for 8-10 months. Dark ruby red in color, it offers up a fragrant bouquet of mineral, Asian spices, damp earth, violets, black cherry, and blackberry. Sweetly-fruited, layered, and well-balanced, this lengthy effort will continue to evolve for another 2-3 years and provide pleasurable drinking through 2020. —**90 Points**"
